The hospitals are fully equipped with the latest state of the art equipment such as Infinity Phaco machine, Zeiss Mel-80 laser Excimer Laser, Zeiss Lumera-I operating microscope, OCT, YAG Laser, Corneal topography, Microscopes & Slit lamps fitted with camera, A & B - Scan, Corneal Pachymeter, Perimeter etc.

- I have been performing phacoemulsification surgeries since year 1994 and perform approximately 2500 surgeries per year.
- I have 18 years of experience in performing phacoemulsification under topical anesthesia.
- I deal with all types of complicated cataract cases like traumatic cataract, congenital and development cataract, posterior polar cataract, brunescant cataract.
- I have special interest in operating on posterior polar , pediatric & traumatic cataracts.
- Besides my other fields of interest are glaucoma surgery & corneal transplantation and ICL implantation.
- I have been performing refractive surgeries like LASIK and LASEK since 2001.

TEACHING EXPERIENCE

I am running international phacoemulsification training programme since two years. Six foreign national eye specialists have completed their Phaco training from our institute. Dr. Avraham Dishy from Switzerland in June 2014, Dr. Saida Taibove from Azerbaijan,

Besides Phaco training we are also running long term fellowship programmes in anterior segment for Indian doctors since three years. The long-term fellowship programme is a fulltime 1.5 years ophthalmologists in India who want to hone their skills further. Two Indian Ophthalmologists have completed their long term fellowship & three fellows are continuing.

I have also conducted symposiums for live cataract surgery and performed live cataract surgeries at several national conferences.
